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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 9-052, as amended, by further amending section 1, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46, and 10-69, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein for certain airports in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 9-052, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 9-071, 10-46 and 10-69, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 1996, for the
8 purpose of funding infrastructure needs, transportation
9 systems, and other economic and social projects, public
10 projects and for other purposes in Chuuk State and for
11 Chuukese outside of Chuuk State. The funds
12 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as


