C.B. NO. 10-288

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$407,500 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, as matching funds for the College of Micronesia - FSM to access a \$100,000 grant from the United States Department of Agriculture Land Grant Program and a \$307,500 grant from the United States Department of Interior Operations and Maintenance Improvement Program (OMIP), and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$407,500, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
3 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
4 September 30, 1998, as matching funds for the College of
5 Micronesia - FSM to access a \$100,000 grant from the United
6 States Department of Agriculture Land Grant Program and a
7 \$307,500 grant from the United States Department of Interior
8 Operations and Maintenance Improvement Program (OMIP).

9 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance
11 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the
12 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
13 appropriated by this act shall be the President of the Federated States of
14 Micronesia. The allottee of the funds appropriated by this act shall be responsible for
15 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
16 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
17 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
18 appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
19 appropriated by section 1 of this act shall lapse as of
20 September 30, 1999.


