

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-39, 11-55 and 11-65, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-55 and 11-65, to modify the use of funds appropriated therein for the State of Yap; by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 11-39, 11-55 and 11-65, to eliminate consultation requirements; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 11-55 and 11-65, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 3. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
7 September 30, 2000, for the purpose of funding infrastructure
8 projects, roads, and other economic and social projects and
9 programs in the State of Yap. The funds appropriated under
10 this section shall be apportioned as follows:

11	(1) Dugor/Bael road.....	\$ 100,000
12	(2) Gargey land development.....	-0-
13	(3) Weloy municipal office construction..	100,000
14	(4) Deechmur, Tomil men's house project..	50,000
15	(5) Outer island agriculture projects/ 16 cultural programs.....	98,000
17	(6) Yap's social development seminars....	25,000
18	(7) Molway, Fanif power & road extension.	25,000
19	(8) Atliw women's community project.....	20,000
20	(9) Rumuu lothog men's house project.....	50,000
21	(10) V6AI equipment purchase.....	80,000

1	(11) Outer island infrastructure	
2	development projects including projects	
3	for outer island communities on Yap	
4	proper (matching funds) PROVIDED THAT	
5	the Department of Finance and	
6	Administration shall allot only	
7	\$50,000 of these funds until such time	
8	as the full amount is available	
9	through recovery of funds previously	
10	allotted in error.....	\$ 270,000
11	(12) Yap Delegation Office including	
12	Delegation Office land lease.....	95,000
13	(13) Beechial box-culvert bridge.....	30,000
14	(14) Scholarship for Yapese for graduate	
15	school studies or studies in high-priority	
16	fields, including aviation and civil	
17	engineering. Funds may be used	
18	for transportation expenses of student	
19	to or from place of study.....	40,000
20	(15) Okau village water service extension.	5,000
21	(16) Completion of Ngulu Women's House and	
22	dispensary buildings.....	5,000
23	(17) Third FSM Games-training and	
24	participation assistance for Outer Island	
25	athletes.....	7,000"

1 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 11-27, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 11-39, 11-55 and 11-65, is hereby further amended to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5 date.

6 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
7 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
8 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
9 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
10 appropriated by section 1 of this act shall be the Executive
11 Director of Chuuk State Commission on Improvement Projects,
12 or his designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated by
13 subsection (1), subsections (3) through (10), subsection (13)
14 and subsections (15) through (17) of section 3 of this act
15 shall be the Governor of the State of Yap. The allottee of
16 the funds appropriated by subsections (2) and (11) of section
17 3 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
18 Transportation, Communication and Infrastructure. The
19 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (12) of
20 section 3 of this act shall be the Speaker of the Congress of
21 the Federated States of Micronesia. The allottee of the
22 funds appropriated by subsection (1) and subsection (3)(a),
23 (3)(b) and (3)(d) of section 4 of this act shall be the
24 Governor of Kosrae State. The allottee of the funds
25 appropriated by subsection (3)(c) of section 4 of this act

1 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Finance and
2 Administration, or his designee. The allottee of the funds
3 appropriated by subsection (2) of section 4 of this act shall
4 be the mayors of the respective municipalities. The allottee
5 of all other funds appropriated by this act shall be the
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or the
7 President's designee. The allottees shall be responsible for
8 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
9 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this
10 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
11 sum appropriated.

12 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds
13 appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

14 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
15 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
16 law without such approval.
