

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 13-36 to specify the use of certain funds appropriated therein, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby

13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2004, to provide
15 funding for social and economic development projects in
16 the State of Yap. The funds appropriated under this
17 section shall be apportioned as follows:

18 (1) Post-secondary scholarships for Yapese students,
19 subject to the following conditions:

20 (a) funds appropriated under this subsection may
21 only be used for tuition, books, and on-campus room and
22 board expenses;

23 (b) the maximum amount available to any
24 individual student enrolled at an institution of higher
25 education located outside the FSM is \$7,000;

1 (c) the maximum amount available to any individual
 2 student enrolled at the College of Micronesia is \$1,500;

4 (d) if the FSM Scholarship Board does not meet to
 5 award scholarship funds appropriated by this section,

19 Section 5. Section 5 of Public Law No. 13-36 is hereby
 20 amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 22 date.

23 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, mana
 24 allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 1, 2
 25 and 3 of this act shall be the President of the

1 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, except
2 that the allottee of the funds appropriated under
3 subsections 1(1), 1(3) and 1(4) of this act shall be the
4 Governor of the State of Kosrae; the allottee of the
5 funds appropriated under subsection 3(2)(a)(i) shall be
6 the mayor of Kolonia Town; the allottee of the funds
7 appropriated under subsections 3(2)(a)(ii), 3(2)(a)(iv)
8 and 3(2)(a)(v) shall be the Sokehs magistrate; and the
9 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
10 3(2)(a)(iii) shall be the mayor of Nukuoro. The
11 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 4 of
12 this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on
13 Improvement Projects, except that the funds appropriated
14 under section [~~4(2)(c)~~] 4(1)(c) of this act shall be
15 allotted to [~~the President of the Federated States of~~
16 ~~Micronesia~~] Southern Namoneas Development Authority.

17 (2) The allottees of the funds appropriated herein
18 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or
19 so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
20 the purpose specified herein, and shall report back to
21 the Congress on the status of these funds no later than
22 September 30, 2005. The authority of the allottees to
23 obligate such funds shall not lapse until fully
24 expended."

1 Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
