

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-100, as amended, by amending section 1 and 6 thereof to modify the use of certain funds, to change the allottee to certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-100, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 10-38, 12-27, 12-61, 12-69 and 13-12, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$1,400,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General  
6 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
7 year ending September 30, 1995, for educational needs and  
8 other economic and social needs in the State of Chuuk. The  
9 funds appropriated under this section shall be disbursed  
10 only for educational needs other than travel, and/or  
11 vehicles, and shall be apportioned as follows:

13 (a) School and classroom

15 (b) School supplies ..... 150,000

16 (c) Transportation ..... 40,000

19 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 8-100, as amended by  
 20 Public Laws Nos. 12-27, 12-44, 12-61, 12-69 and 13-5, is hereby  
 21 further amended to read as follows:

22 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 23 date.

24 (1) All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,  
 25 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with

1 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial  
2 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds  
3 appropriated under subsection (3) of section 1 of this act  
4 shall be the Northern Namoneas Development Authority. The  
5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection (4) of  
6 section 1 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
7 Development Authority. The allottee of the funds  
8 appropriated under subsection (5) of section 1 of this act  
9 shall be the [~~Pattiw Development Authority~~] Executive  
10 Director of the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement  
11 Projects. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
12 subsections (1), (2), (6), (7), (8) and (9) of section 1 of  
13 this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement  
14 Projects. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
15 section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of  
16 Kosrae. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
17 subsections (1), (3) and (4) of section 4 of this act shall  
18 be the Governor of the State of Yap. The allottee of the  
19 funds appropriated under subsection (2) of section 4 of this  
20 act shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM.  
21 The allottee of all other funds appropriated by this act  
22 shall be the President of the Federated State of Micronesia  
23 or the President's designee. The allottees shall be  
24 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much  
25 thereof as be necessary, are solely for the purposes

1 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred  
2 in excess of the sum appropriated.

3 (2) The authority of the allottees to obligate funds  
4 appropriated by this act shall not lapse."

5 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
7 becoming law without such approval.
