

A RESOLUTION

Acceding to the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of Crimes Against Internationally Protected Persons, Including Diplomatic Agents.

1 WHEREAS, the purpose and principles of the Charter of the
2 United Nations are to maintain international peace and to promote
3 friendly relations and cooperation among States; and

4 WHEREAS, diplomatic agents and other internationally protected
5 persons play a critical role in the maintenance of international
6 peace and the promotion of friendly relations and cooperation
7 among States; and

8 WHEREAS, crimes against diplomatic agents and other
9 internationally protected persons pose a serious threat to the
10 effort to maintain international peace and to promote friendly
11 relations and cooperation among States; and

12 WHEREAS, the Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of
13 Crimes Against Internationally Protected Persons, Including
14 Diplomatic Agents provides appropriate and effective measures for
15 the prevention and punishment of such crimes; now, therefore

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Thirteenth Congress of the Federated States of M
17 Crimes Against Internationally Protected Persons, Including
18 Diplomatic Agents;
