

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to section 8 of article IX and section 4 of article X of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of increasing the length of terms for members of Congress elected from congressional districts in each state based on population to four years.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. It is hereby proposed that sections 8 of article
2 IX of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia shall
3 be amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 8. The Congress consists of one member elected
5 at large from each state on the basis of state equality,
6 and additional members elected from congressional
7 districts in each state apportioned by population.

8 Members [~~elected on the basis of state equality~~] serve
9 for a 4-year term [~~, and all other members for 2 years~~].

10 Each member has one vote, except on the final reading of
11 bills. Congressional elections are held [~~biennially~~] as
12 provided by statute."

13 Section 2. It is hereby proposed that section 4 of article X
14 of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia shall be
15 amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 4. A person is ineligible to become President
17 unless he is a member of Congress [~~for a 4 year term~~]
18 elected at large from a state on the basis of state
