
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by Public Law No. 14-95, by further amending sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 12 thereof, in order to provide funding for the full fiscal year ending September 30, 2007 by appropriating funds for the third and fourth quarters, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

16 (1) General Provisions.

17 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
19 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
21 amended Compact of Free Association between the United
22 States Government and the Government of the Federated
23 States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

24 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
25 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
2 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
3 of the sum appropriated.

4 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated
5 by this act are as follows:

6 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
7 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

8 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall

20 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

21 (i) section 8 subsection (7)(a) through (d)
22 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice
23 of the respective state,

24 (ii) section 8 subsection (7)(1) - the
25 allottee shall be the Yap Office of the Public Defender,

2 (iii) section 9(1)(a) through [~~e~~] e - the
3 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
4 College of Micronesia-FSM.

5 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to
6 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
7 of September 30, 2007, EXCEPT the funds appropriated
8 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."

9 Section 11. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11 becoming law without such approval.
