

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-84, as amended, by amending sections 2, 6 and 7 thereof to specify and change the uses of lapsed fund as of June 30, 2006 in the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia previously appropriated to fund public projects and social programs in the States of Pohnpei, Chuuk and Yap, by amending section 9 thereof to change the allottee of certain funds, to allow reprogramming of certain funds, to encourage the allottee of certain funds to work with the recipients of projects to meet certain requirements and to require that allottee of certain funds report to Congress as to the progress of the projects in the State of Yap, and to change the lapse date of funds appropriated by this act, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 14-96, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 2. The sum of \$56,522 or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary that lapsed as of June 30, 2006 as
6 required by Public Law No. 14-35 from Public Laws Nos.
7 7-35, 8-19, 8-75, 8-100, 8-115, 9-052, 10-120, 10-143
8 and 11-36 for Chuuk State At Large, and the sum of
9 \$27,300 or so much thereof as may be necessary that
10 lapsed as of June 30, 2006 as required by Public Law No.
11 14-35 from Public Law No. 8-134 for Election District
12 No. 1, Chuuk State, is hereby reappropriated from the
13 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
14 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, for the
15 purpose of funding projects and social programs as
16 follows:

16 "Section 4. The sum of \$561,476 or so much thereof as
 17 may be necessary that lapsed as of June 30, 2006 or as
 18 required by Public Law No. 14-35 from Public Laws Nos.
 19 7-39, 8-19, 8-100, 8-115, 9-052, 9-095, 10-120, 10-143,
 20 11-36 and 11-59 for the State of Yap, is hereby
 21 reappropriated from the General Fund of the Federated
 22 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
 23 September 30, 2006, for the purpose of funding projects
 24 and social programs in the State of Yap [---], and is
 25 apportioned as follow:

25 Section 3. Section 7 of Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by

1 Public Law No. 14-96, is hereby further amended to read as
 2 follows:

3 "Section 5. The sum of \$46,372 or so much thereof as
 4 may be necessary that lapsed as of June 30, 2006 or as
 5 required by Public Law No. 14-35 from Public Laws Nos.
 6 8-100, 9-052, 9-095, 10-120, 10-126, 10-143 and 11-59 is
 7 hereby reappropriated from the General Fund of the
 8 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
 9 ending September 30, 2006, for the purpose of funding
 10 projects and social programs for Election District No. 1
 11 in the State of Pohnpei as follow:

20 Section 4. Section 9 of Public Law No. 14-84, as amended by
 21 Public Law No. 14-96 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

22 "Section 6. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 23 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
 24 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
 25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The

1 allottee of the funds appropriated in Sections 1, 4, and
2 5 [~~and 6~~] of this Act shall be the President of the
3 Federated States of Micronesia or the President's
4 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated in
5 Sections 2 and 3 of this Act shall be the Chuuk State
6 Commission on Improvement Project. The allottee of
7 funds appropriated in Section 6 of this Act shall be the
8 Governor of the State of Yap. The Governor may
9 reprogram up to fifteenth percent (15%) to and from the
10 funds appropriated for Yap State projects and programs
11 in section 6 (line item projects for the State of Yap);
12 PROVIDED THAT, the Governor first provides to the
13 Secretary of Finance and Administration a written
14 advisory specifying the amount to be reprogrammed and
15 the reason. The Governor is encouraged to work closely
16 with the recipients of Yap community projects, and may
17 choose not to implement any project that does not meet
18 the requirements in the State of Yap Strategic
19 Development Plan (SDP). The recipients of the projects
20 in Section 6 of this Act shall seek supplemental funding
21 (in-kind, labor services or local materials) from other
22 sources to supplement its projects.
23 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that
24 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are
25 used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and

1 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
2 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated in
3 section 6 of this act shall report to Congress as to the
4 progress of the project. The authority of the allottee
5 to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse
6 as of September 30, 200[8] 9."

7 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9 becoming law without such approval.
