
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To enact the FY 2008 budget in order to provide funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Shall read as follows: The sum of \$39,153,093 or
2 so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from
3 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
4 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of funding
5 the operations of all branches of the National Government of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs,
7 grants, subsidies and contributions; and for other purposes. The
8 sum appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

9 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The
10 sum of \$17,497,825 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
11 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States
12 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for

14 the National Government during the fiscal year 2008. The sum

5 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or
6 from the personnel budget line items shall not be permitted. The
7 President may reprogram up to 10% to or from, whichever is less,
8 from the funds appropriated to each department and office in
9 section 2 (Operating expenses of the Executive Branch).
10 Reprogramming of funds within a department, office or agency shall
11 be effected by the head of such department, office or agency by
12 specifying in writing to the Secretary of Finance and
13 Administration, FSM National Government, the accounts for which
14 funding is either increased or decreased. The President shall
15 report to Congress within one month of the last day of each
16 financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a
17 department, office or agency.

18 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
19 date.

20 (1) General Provisions.

21 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
22 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
23 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
24 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the
25 amended Compact of Free Association between the United

1 States Government and the Government of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

3 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for
4 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
6 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
7 of the sum appropriated.

8 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated
9 by this act are as follows:

10 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
11 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

12 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
13 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
14 of Micronesia;

15 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall
16 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
17 Federated States of Micronesia;

18 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall
19 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
20 Micronesia;

21 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
22 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
23 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of
24 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

1 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice
2 of the respective state,

3 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (d) - the
4 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
5 College of Micronesia-FSM.

6 (3) Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to
7 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
8 of September 30, 2008, EXCEPT the funds appropriated
9 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

10 Section 13. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
12 becoming law without such approval.
