

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18 and 15-26, by amending sections 1, 2, 7, 8, and 9 thereof, in order to appropriate an additional \$799,000 from the General Fund for fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. The title of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 15-18 and 15-26, is hereby further amended to read  
3 as follows:

4                   “To appropriate the sum of \$42,417,811 from the General  
5 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the  
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose  
7 of funding the operations of all branches of the  
8 National Government of the Federated States of  
9 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
10 subsidies and contributions and to establish a capital  
11 and human resource development budget, and for other  
12 purposes.”

13           Section 2. Section 1 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by  
14 Public Law No. 15-18 and 15-26, is hereby further amended to read  
15 as follows:

16                   “Section 1. The sum of \$42,417,811 from or so much  
17 thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated from  
18 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia  
19 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, for the  
20 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the

1 National Government of the Federated States of  
2 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants,  
3 subsidies and contributions and to establish a capital  
4 and human resource development budget, and for other  
5 purposes. The sum of appropriated herein shall be  
6 apportioned as follows:"

7 Section 3. Section 2 of Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by  
8 Public Law No. 15-18 and 15-26, is hereby further amended to read  
9 as follows:

10 "Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch.  
11 The sum of \$17,774,931 or so much thereof as may be  
12 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund  
13 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal  
14 year ending September 30, 2008, for the purpose of  
15 funding the operations of the Executive Branch of the  
16 National Government during the fiscal year 2008. The  
17 sum appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as  
18 follows:

Capacity Building, PROVIDED THAT the sum  
appropriated herein shall be deemed to come  
from funds available under the amended Compact  
for Capacity Building and, PROVIDED THAT,  
these funds shall not be allotted or obligated  
until such time as formal approval has been  
obtained in accordance with the Amended  
Compact of Free  
Association ..... 350,000"

Section 8. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
becoming law without such approval.
