

AN ACT

To appropriate \$33,321,789 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; to extend the lapse date for funds appropriated in fiscal year ending September 30, 2008 from supplementary education grant (SEG), and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Shall read as follows: To appropriate the sum of  
2 \$33,321,789 from the General Fund of the Federated States of  
3 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for the  
4 purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National  
5 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,  
6 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions; and for  
7 other purposes. Of the total amount of funds appropriated herein,  
8 \$789,832 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
9 amended Compact from the health sector; \$4,149,567 shall be deemed  
10 to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the  
11 education sector (leaving \$253,673 unappropriated); \$100,000 shall  
12 be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact  
13 from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come  
14 from funds available under the amended Compact from the  
15 infrastructure sector; and \$0 shall be deemed to come from funds  
16 available under the supplemental education grant (SEG). The sum  
17 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

1           Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The  
2 sum of \$14,752,877 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is  
3 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States  
4 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2009, for  
5 the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of  
6 the National Government during the fiscal year 2009. Of the total  
7 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$789,832 shall be deemed to  
8 come from funds available under the amended Compact from the  
9 health sector; \$349,567 shall be deemed to come from funds  
10 available under the amended Compact from the education sector; and  
11 \$0 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the  
12 supplemental education grant (SEG). The sum appropriated by this

3 Section 11. Reprogramming. Reprogramming of funds into or  
4 from the personnel budget line items shall not be permitted. The  
5 President, Speaker and Chief Justice may reprogram up to 10% to or  
6 from the funds appropriated in sections 2 (Operating expenses of  
7 the Executive Branch), 3 (Operating expenses of the Legislative  
8 Branch), and 4 (Operating expenses of the National Judicial Branch)  
9 respectively. Reprogramming of funds within a department, office  
10 or agency shall be effected by the head of such department, office  
11 or agency by specifying in writing to the Secretary of Finance and  
12 Administration, FSM National Government, the accounts for which  
13 funding is either increased or decreased. The President shall  
14 report to Congress within one month of the last day of each  
15 financial quarter all amounts reprogrammed inter or intra a  
16 department, office or agency.

17 Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
18 date.

19 (1) General Provisions.

20 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
21 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
22 accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
23 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the  
24 amended Compact of Free Association between the United  
25 States Government and the Government of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia and its related agreements.

2 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for  
3 ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be  
4 necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in  
5 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
6 of the sum appropriated.

7 (2) Allottees. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
8 by this act are as follows:

9 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall  
10 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

11 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall  
12 be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States  
13 of Micronesia;

14 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall  
15 be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the  
16 Federated States of Micronesia;

17 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall  
18 be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of  
19 Micronesia;

20 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these  
21 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of  
22 Micronesia, EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of  
23 sections 8 through 9 of this act:

24 (i) Section 8 subsection (13) (a) through (d)  
25 - the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice

1 of the respective state,

2 (ii) section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the  
3 allottee of these funds shall be the President of the  
4 College of Micronesia-FSM.

5 Lapse Date. The authority of the allottee to obligate  
6 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of  
7 September 30, 2009, EXCEPT the funds appropriated under  
8 section 9 of this act shall not lapse.

9 Section 13. The authority of the allottees to expend funds  
10 appropriated in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2008, in  
11 Public Law No. 15-11, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 15-18, 15-26,  
12 15-33 and 15-43 (the FY08 Budget) from supplementary education  
13 grant (SEG) shall lapse as of September 30, 2009.

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24 Section 14. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
25 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its

1 becoming law without such approval.
