

A RESOLUTION

To approve a sum of \$150,000 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services for the establishment of the FSM-Early Hearing Detection and Intervention Project in the Federated States of Micronesia.

1           WHEREAS, the Department of Health, particularly the Program  
2 under the Division of Health for Family Planning and Mother Child  
3 Health care (MCH), aspires to establish a FSM-Early Hearing  
4 Detection and Intervention Project in the Federated States of  
5 Micronesia; and

6           WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia does not have a  
7 comprehensive early hearing screening, detection and intervention  
8 services for infants in the FSM; and

9           WHEREAS, Department of Health requires funding to establish  
10 the FSM-Early Hearing Detection and Intervention Project (FSM-  
11 EHDI) in the Federated States of Micronesia; and

12           WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human  
13 Services has granted \$150,000 to the Federated States of  
14 Micronesia for the establishment of the FSM Early Hearing  
15 Detection and Intervention Project; and

16           WHEREAS, section 210 of title 55 of the Code of the Federated  
17 States of Micronesia requires Congressional approval of foreign  
18 financial assistance; now, therefore

19           BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated  
20 States of Micronesia, Fifth Special Session, 2008 that the United

1 States Department of Health and Human Services grant described  
2 herein is hereby approved; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
4 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States  
5 of Micronesia and the FSM Department of Health.
