A RESOLUTION

To approve the agreement for the grant of a foreign financial assistance from the United Nations Trust Fund in the amount of \$117,568.00 for the purposes defraying the costs and expenses associated with the task of delineating the outer limits of the FSM Continental Shelf beyond its 200 nautical miles exclusive economic zone.

- 1 WHEREAS, the FSM Ambassador to the United Nations has
- 2 executed an agreement for the financial assistance grant from the
- 3 United Nations Trust Fund, in the amount of \$117,568.00 for the
- 4 purposes of defraying the costs and expenses associated with the
- 5 task of delineating the outer limits of the FSM Continental Shelf
- 6 beyond its 200 miles exclusive economic zone; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Article 76 of the United Nations Convention on the
- 8 Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), of which FSM is a party, requires the
- 9 costal states, of which the FSM is one, to delineate the outer
- 10 limits of their Continental Shelf; the FSM is an island nation and
- 11 its surrounding ocean floor with geographic features includes a
- 12 Continental Shelf, as defined b Article 76 (of the UNCLOS), which
- 13 permits the FSM to make a submission for the extension of its
- 14 Continental Shelf beyond the 200 miles EEZ in conformity with the
- 15 decision adopted by the Eighteen Meeting of States Parties to the
- 16 UN Law of the Sea Convention; and
- 17 WHEREAS, studies show that there are three major areas in and
- 18 adjacent to FSM exclusive economic zone (200 nautical miles) that
- 19 have potential extensions of the FSM Continental Shelf beyond the

- 1 200 miles, to wit:
- 2 (1) The Euripik Rise, extending from the island of Euripik
- 3 in South Western Yap Sate has a potential extension of 75,000
- 4 square kilometers; (2) The Nussau Ridge in the Southern part of
- 5 Chuuk Sate has potential extension of 26,000 square kilometers;
- 6 and (3) The Ontong Java Plateau in the Southern Pohnpei State has
- 7 a potential extension of 156,000 square kilometers; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the FSM needs the \$117,568 for the purpose of
- 9 defraying the costs and expenses associated with the preparation
- 10 of FSM's position papers regarding the extension of its
- 11 Continental Shelf beyond its 200 miles Exclusive Economic Zone;
- 12 the grant, when received, is a foreign financial assistance,
- 13 within the meaning of FSM Const. art. XII, section 1(b); 55 FSMC
- 14 section 210 (1)(b), and, as such, it shall be deposited in the
- 15 Foreign Financial Assistance Fund established pursuant to FSM
- 16 Const. art. XII, section 1(b) and 55 FSMC section 210 (3), and the
- 17 same shall be distributed, in accordance with the "particular
- 18 distribution" set forth in the terms and conditions of the grant
- 19 award, pursuant to FSM Const. art. XII, section 1(b), without
- 20 appropriation; and
- 21 WHEREAS, adoption of the resolution is in the best interest
- 22 of the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia; now,
- 23 therefore
- 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated
- 25 States of Micronesia, Sixth Regular Session, 2009 that the
