

A RESOLUTION

To shorten the Second Special Session of the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.

1 WHEREAS, the Second Special Session of the Fifteenth Congress
2 of the Federated States of Micronesia was convened on September 5,
3 2007 and was scheduled to continue for six consecutive days
4 thereafter; and

5 WHEREAS, the Congress may, by a majority vote of all the
6 Members, and pursuant to section 202 of title 3 of the Code of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia, shorten the session by resolution;
8 now, therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Fifteenth Congress of the Federated
10 States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2007, that the
11 Congress hereby shortens this Special Session of the Fifteenth
12 Congress to four days so as to adjourn on September 8, 2007;

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this
14 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
15 of Micronesia.
