
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, in order to appropriate \$60,000 of supplemental funding for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to fund the Development Partners meeting in June of 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby further amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of \$~~[45,327,053]~~ 45,387,053, or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary, from the
7 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
8 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for
9 the purpose of funding the operations of all
10 branches of the National Government of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia, its agencies, various
12 programs, grants, subsidies and contributions. Of
13 the total amount of funds appropriated herein,
14 \$4,437,560 shall be deemed to come from funds
15 available under the amended Compact from the
16 education sector subject to the receipt of Grant
17 Awards under the amended Compact; \$1,176,656 shall
18 be deemed to come from funds available under the

1 Supplemental Education Grant; \$878,750 shall be
2 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
3 Compact from the health sector subject to the receipt
4 of Grant Awards under the amended Compact; \$329,598
5 shall be deemed to come from funds available under
6 the amended Compact from the capacity building
7 sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds
8 available under the amended Compact from the private
9 sector development sector; and \$1,194,212 shall be
10 deemed to come from funds available under the
11 amended Compact from the infrastructure sector.

12 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
13 by Public Laws Nos. 17-28 and 17-31, is hereby amended to read
14 as follows:

15 "Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

16 The sum of \$~~[9,526,230]~~ 9,586,230, or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
18 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
19 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
20 2012, for the following grants, subsidies and
21 contributions during fiscal year 2012. Of the total
22 amount of funds appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be
23 deemed to come from funds available under the amended
24 Compact from the education sector; and \$-0- shall be
25 deemed to come from funds available under the
