
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended by Public Law No. 17-28, to change the use of funds previously appropriated for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 17-19, as amended
2 by Public Law No. 17-28, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions.

4 The sum of \$9,476,230, or so much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General
6 Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, for the
8 following grants, subsidies and contributions during
9 fiscal year 2012. Of the total amount of funds
10 appropriated herein, \$-0- shall be deemed to come
11 from funds available under the amended Compact from
12 the education sector; and \$-0- shall be deemed to
13 come from funds available under the Supplemental
14 Education Grant. The sum appropriated by this
15 section shall be apportioned as follows:
