

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-35, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-49, 18-61, 18-63, 18-78, 18-98 and 18-111, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 18-35, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 18-49, 18-61 and 18-63, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the sum of \$4,900,000 appropriated by  
5 this act, \$2,100,000 is apportioned for public  
6 projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk.
