

A RESOLUTION

Approving the submission of a grant proposal in the amount of \$40,000 from the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs to fund the National Public Health Improvement Initiative, to the United States Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

1           WHEREAS, a grant proposal has been developed worth \$40,000 by  
2 the FSM Department of Health and Social Services to fund the  
3 National Public Health Improvement Initiative for the FSM; and

4           WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health and Human  
5 Services Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has been  
6 identified as the potential source of funding if the grant  
7 proposal is accepted and approved by the institution; and

8           WHEREAS, the purpose of the assistance is to assist the  
9 FSM Government, in collaboration with the State Government, for  
10 the improvement of the laboratory services at the State  
11 hospitals throughout the FSM; and

12           WHEREAS, Section 211 of title 55 of the Code of the  
13 Federated States of Micronesia requires that prior to the  
14 submittal of any first year or first time application, proposal  
15 or pre-expenditure report such application proposal in pre-  
16 expenditure report shall be submitted to Congress for review  
17 and approval by resolution; now; therefore,

18           BE IT RESOLVED by the Eighteenth Congress of the Federated  
19 States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2013, that

1 Congress hereby approves the \$40,000 grant proposal from the  
2 FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs to fund the  
3 National Public Health Improvement Initiative and its  
4 submission to U.S Department of Health and Human Services  
5 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; and

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copies of this  
7 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States  
8 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Health and  
9 Social Affairs, and United States Embassy in Kolonia
