

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-106, 18-113, 18-121 and 19-05, by amending sections 2, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the States of Yap, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 18-99 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

12 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-99, as amended by
13 Public Laws Nos. 18-113, 18-121 and 19-05, is hereby further amended
14 to read as follows:

15 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
16 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
17 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
18 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
19 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
20 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
21 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
22 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
23 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
24 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
25 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap

1 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
2 appropriated under section 3 shall be the President or
3 his designee, EXCEPT THAT the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under section 3(a), (b), (c), (d), (e),
5 (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l), (m), (n), (o) and (u)
6 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government. The
7 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this
8 act shall be the President or his designee, EXCEPT that
9 the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(a)
10 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Education;
11 the allottee of funds appropriated under sections
12 4(1)(c), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(h) and 4(2) shall be Secretary of
13 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
14 Infrastructure; the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 section 4(1)(d) shall be the Pohnpei Port Authority; the
16 allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1)(f)
17 shall be the Nett District Government; the allottee of
18 funds appropriated under section 4(1)(g) shall be the
19 Secretary of the Department of Resources and
20 Development; the allottee of funds appropriated under
21 sections 4(3)(b) and 4(4)(a) shall be the Pohnpei
22 Transportation Authority and the allottee of funds
23 appropriated under section 4(3)(g) shall be the COM-FSM
24 Cooperative Extension Service. The allottee of funds
25 appropriated under sections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this

1 act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
 2 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
 3 subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlock
 4 Islands Development Authority. The allottee of funds
 5 appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
 6 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The
 7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of
 8 this act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority.
 9 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
 10 appropriated by this act shall lapse on September 30,
 11 2016."

12 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
 13 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
 14 becoming law without such approval.
