
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 20-42 by appropriating \$5,333,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to provide funding for the set up and operations costs of a consulate on the West Coast of the United States and for the FSM Trust Fund, to make a technical correction, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42 as hereby amended to read
2 as follows:

3 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
4 appropriate the sum of ~~[\$67,903,100]~~ \$73,236,100 from the
5 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose of
7 funding the operations of all branches of the National
8 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
9 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
10 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development.
11 The National Government's share of the Amended Compact
12 funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National
13 Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental
14 Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for
15 the Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein
16 shall be apportioned as follows:

17 Section 2. Section 8 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby
18 amended to read as follows:

1 “Section 8. Grants, Subsidies and Contributions. The sum
2 of [~~\$11,810,827~~] \$12,143,827, or so much thereof as may be
3 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
4 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
5 ending September 30, 2018, for the following grants,
6 subsidies and contributions. The sum appropriated by this
7 section shall be apportioned as follows:

1 Section 3. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

4 The sum of [~~\$27,270,106~~] \$32,270,106, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the
8 following capital improvements, development programs,
9 and projects and human resources development. Of the
10 total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022
11 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
12 Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant
13 and \$5,252,250 shall be deemed to come from funds
14 available under the Amended Compact from Compact Sector
15 Grants. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
16 apportioned as follows:

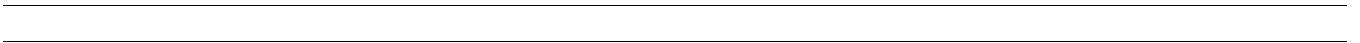
