
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Law No. 20-54, to sub-divide the Section 9 line item titled Conservation Society in Each State, and to name the Governor of Chuuk State as the allottee for the Chuuk State share of this line item, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 20-42, as previously
2 amended by Public Law No. 20-54, is hereby further amended, to
3 read as follows:

4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.

5 The sum of **\$36,270,106**, or so much thereof as may be
6 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8 year ending September 30, 2018, for the following
9 capital improvements, development programs, and projects
10 and human resources development. Of the total amount of
11 funds appropriated herein, **\$1,246,022** shall be deemed to
12 come from funds available under the Amended Compact from
13 the Supplemental Education Grant and **\$5,252,250** shall be
14 deemed to come from funds available under the Amended
15 Compact from Compact Sector Grants. The sum
16 appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as
17 follows:

4 Section 2. Section 12 of Public Law No. 20-42 is hereby
5 amended to read as follows:

6 "Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
7 Lapse Dates.

8 (1) General provisions.

9 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
11 accordance with applicable law, including, but not
12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

13 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
14 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
15 necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
16 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
17 of the sums appropriated.

18 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
19 appropriated by this act are as follows:

20 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be
21 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

22 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be
23 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
24 Micronesia;

25 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be

1 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated
2 States of Micronesia;

3 (d) Section 5 – the allottee of these funds shall be
4 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
5 Micronesia;

6 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
7 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
9 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

10 (i) Section 8(1)(g) – the allottee of these
11 funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on
12 Compact Review and Planning;

13 (ii) Section 8(9) – the allottee of these funds
14 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
15 States of Micronesia;

16 (iii) Section 8(12)(a) – the allottee of these
17 funds shall be the President of the College of
18 Micronesia-FSM;

19 (iv) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the allottee
20 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the
21 respective State Supreme Court;

22 (v) Section 9(1) – the allottee of these funds
23 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-
24 FSM[+];

25 (vi) Section 9(16)(a) – the allottee of these

1 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT, for the share of funds from
3 this line item for the Conservation Society in Chuuk,
4 the allottee shall be the Governor of the State of
5 Chuuk;

6 [~~(vi)~~](vii) Section 9(16)(f) – the allottee of
7 these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.

8 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
9 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
10 of September 30, 2018; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
11 appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not
12 lapse.”

13 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15 becoming law without such approval.
