

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Law No. 20-57, by amending sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 20-57, is hereby further amended, to read as  
3 follows:

22 Section 4. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by  
 23 Public Law No. 20-57, is hereby further amended, to read as  
 24 follows:

25 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse

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1 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
2 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
3 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
4 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
5 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
6 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
7 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no  
8 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
9 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
10 under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the President  
11 of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;  
12 PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
13 subsections 2(a) to 2(af) of this act shall be the Mayor  
14 of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of  
15 funds appropriated under subsection 2(ag) shall be the  
16 Secretary of Education or his designee; the allottee of  
17 funds appropriated under subsections 2(ah) to [~~2(am)~~  
18 2(a3)] of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal  
19 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds  
20 appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b), 3(1)(c),  
21 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r), 3(2)(b),  
22 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e) [~~and~~], 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d),  
23 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this act shall be the  
24 Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds  
25 appropriated under subsections 3(3)(f), 3(3)(l) and

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1           3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmenlap of Kitti; the  
2           allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(3)(q)  
3           and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Utility  
4           Corporation; the allottee of fund appropriated under  
5           subsections 4(7)(a), 4(7)(b), 4(7)(c), 4(7)(d) and 4(7)(e)  
6           shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The  
7           allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 4(1),  
8           4(3), 4(6) and 4(7) of this act shall be the Governor of  
9           Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds  
10          appropriated under subsection 4(2) of this act shall be  
11          the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the  
12          allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)  
13          of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development  
14          Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
15          subsection 4(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk  
16          Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to  
17          obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
18          September 30, 2020."

19          Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
20          President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
21          becoming law without such approval.
