

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-54 and 20-64, in order to appropriate \$4,451,203 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, to amend certain section sub-titles, to change the allottee for a particular line item, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended by
2 Public Law No. 20-54, is hereby further amended to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to
5 appropriate the sum of [~~\$77,236,100~~] \$81,687,303 from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the
7 fiscal year ending September 30, 2018, for the purpose of
8 funding the operations of all branches of the National
9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its
10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and
11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development.
12 The National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds
13 has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National
14 Government will retain 10 percent of the Supplemental
15 Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget for the
16 Department of Education. The sum appropriated herein shall be
17 apportioned as follows:"

12 Section 6. Section 12 of Public Law No. 20-42, as amended
 13 by Public Law No. 20-64, is hereby further amended to read as

15 Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse
 16 Dates.

17 (1) General provisions.

18 (a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 19 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 20 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited
 21 to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.

22 (b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring
 23 that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 24 are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and
 25 that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums

1 appropriated.

2 (2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds appropriated
3 by this act are as follows:

4 (a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall be
5 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;

6 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be
7 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of
8 Micronesia;

9 (c) Section 4 - the allottee of these funds shall be
10 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated
11 States of Micronesia;

12 (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be
13 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia;

14 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
15 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
16 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
17 subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:

18 (i) Section 8(1)(g) - the allottee of these funds
19 shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on Compact Review
20 and Planning;

21 (ii) Section 8(9) - the allottee of these funds
22 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
23 States of Micronesia;

24 (iii) Section 8(12)(a) - the allottee of these
25 funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-

1 FSM;

2 (iv) Section 8(12)(e) through (h) - the allottee
3 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective
4 State Supreme Court;

5 (v) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these funds
6 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

7 (vi) Section 9(16)(a) - the allottee of these
8 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT, for the share of funds from this
10 line item for the Conservation Society in Chuuk, the
11 allottee shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk, AND,
12 for the share of funds from this line item for the
13 Conservation Society in Yap, the allottee shall be the
14 Governor of the State of Yap, AND, for the share of funds
15 from this line item for the Conservation Society in Kosrae,
16 the allottee shall be the Kosrae Civil Society;

17 (vii) Section 9(16)(f) - the allottee of these
18 funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.

19 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to obligate
20 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
21 30, 2018; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated
22 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse."
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1 Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
