

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61, 20-69, 20-91 and 20-96, by amending sections 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other projects and programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61 and 20-91, is hereby further
3 amended, to read as follows:

4 "Section 3. Of the \$9,000,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$3,000,000 shall be apportioned for priority
6 infrastructure projects and other projects and programs
7 in the state of Pohnpei.

5 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-53, as amended by
6 Public Laws Nos. 20-57, 20-61 and 20-91, is hereby further
7 amended, to read as follows:

8 "Section 5. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
9 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
11 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
13 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
15 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
16 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
18 under sections 2 and 3 of this act shall be the
19 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
20 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 2(a) to 2(af) and 2(ay)
22 of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government
23 or his designee; [~~the allottee of funds appropriated~~
24 ~~under subsection 2(ag) shall be the Secretary of~~
25 ~~Education or his designee;~~] the allottee of funds

1 appropriated under subsections [~~2(a)~~] 2(ag) to 2(a2) of
2 this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak Municipal
3 Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsections 3(1)(a), 3(1)(b),
5 3(1)(c), 3(1)(e), 3(1)(g), 3(1)(j), 3(1)(p), 3(1)(r),
6 3(2)(b), 3(2)(c), 3(2)(d), 3(2)(e), 3(2)(o), 3(3)(d),
7 3(3)(n), 3(3)(t) and 3(3)(x) of this act shall be the
8 Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of funds
9 appropriated under subsections 3(3)(f), 3(3)(l) and
10 3(3)(m) of this act shall be the Lukenmenlap of Kitti;
11 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
12 3(3)(q) and 3(3)(r) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
13 Utility Corporation; the allottee of fund appropriated
14 under subsections 4(7)(a), 4(7)(b), 4(7)(c), 4(7)(d) and
15 4(7)(e) shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
16 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
17 subsection 4(1), 4(3), 4(6) and 4(7) of this act shall
18 be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the
19 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)
20 of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development
21 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated
22 under subsection 4(4) of this act shall be the Southern
23 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
24 funds appropriated under subsection 4(5) of this act
25 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The

1 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
2 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2020."

3 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
4 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
5 becoming law without such approval.
