
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160 and 20-14, in order to appropriate \$9,735,140 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, is
3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 follows: To appropriate the sum of \$~~[75,125,510]~~
6 84,860,650 from the General Fund of the Federated
7 States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
8 September 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding the
9 operations of all branches of the National Government
10 of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies,
11 various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions
12 and Capital and Human Resources Development. The
13 National Government's share of the Amended Compact
14 funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT, the
15 National Government will retain 10 percent of the
16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in
17 the budget for the Department of Education. The sum
18 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:"
