
A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01 and 20-14, to clarify the use of funding for the Open Access Entity, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146 and 19-160,
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
5 The sum of \$32,329,363, which includes \$556,074 in SEG
6 funding that was previously omitted, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
8 from the General Fund of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30,
10 2017, for the following capital improvements,
11 development programs, and projects and human resources
12 development. Of the total amount of funds
13 appropriated herein, \$1,802,096 shall be deemed to
14 come from funds available under the Amended Compact
15 from the Supplemental Education Grant and \$9,545,500
16 shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
17 Amended Compact from Compact Sector Grants. The sum
