

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$250,000 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration, to support and fund FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs Opioid State Targeted Response Project, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1           WHEREAS, on April 21, 2017, the United States through the  
2 Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and  
3 Mental Health Administration, issued the Notice of Award for  
4 financial assistance in the amount of \$250,000 to fund and  
5 support the project entitled: "Federated States of Micronesia  
6 Opioid State Targeted Response"; and

7           WHEREAS, the purpose of this grant is to increase access  
8 to treatment, reduce unmet treatment needs, and reduce opioid  
9 overdose related deaths through the provision of prevention,  
10 treatment and recovery activities for opioid use disorder  
11 including prescription opioids as well as illicit drugs such as  
12 heroin; and

13           WHEREAS, this is the first year of this grant for budget  
14 period from May 01, 2017, to April 30; and

15           WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the  
16 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended,  
17 provides that for foreign financial assistance to be valid, it
