

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$284,160 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, to fund the implementation of the Federated States of Micronesia Comprehensive Cancer Control (CCC) Plan to reduce cancer burden in the FSM for the budget period from June 30, 2017, to June 29, 2018, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, the United States through the Department of Health
2 and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,
3 issued a Notice of Award of financial assistance on July 20, 2017,
4 in the amount of \$284,160; and

5 WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to fund the project
6 entitled: "Implementing the FSM's CCC Plan to Reduce Cancer Burden
7 in the FSM", including the program's operational costs, personnel
8 salaries, supplies and contractual services; and

9 WHEREAS, section 210 (2) of title 55 of the Code of the
10 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires
11 that for an agreement on foreign financial assistance to be valid
12 it must be approved by Congress by resolution; and

13 WHEREAS, the FSM Government expresses appreciation to the
14 United States Government for the federal grant programs made
15 available to the Federated States of Micronesia; now, therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twentieth Congress of the Federated
17 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 2017, that Congress
18 hereby approves the \$284,160 grant from the U.S. Department of

1 Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and
2 Prevention, to fund the implementation of the Federated States of
3 Micronesia CCC's Plan, including all the terms and conditions
4 thereof; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
6 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
7 of Micronesia and the Secretary of the Department of Health and
8 Social Affairs.
