

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant in the amount of \$30,000 from the United Nations Educational Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) to fund and support the implementation of the Federated States of Micronesia' Initial Non-Invasive Clearing of Vegetation Overgrowth at Nan Madol Project administered by the FSM National Archives, Culture and Historic Preservation Office, including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1           WHEREAS, the United Nations Educational Scientific and  
2 Cultural Organization (UNESCO), extend to the Government of the  
3 Federated States of Micronesia a grant in the amount of \$30,000  
4 which is approved by UNESCO as evidenced by the attached letter  
5 dated March 31, 2017; and

6           WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is to provide the  
7 essential funding to the FSM National Archives, Culture and  
8 Historic Preservation Office for the implementation of the  
9 Initial Non-invasive Clearing of Vegetation Overgrowth at Nan  
10 Madol Project, and its related activities; and

11           WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the  
12 Federated States of Micronesia, (Annotated), as amended,  
13 requires that for foreign financial assistance to be valid it  
14 must be approved by Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

15           BE IT RESOLVED by the Twentieth congress of the Federated  
16 States of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 2018, that  
17 Congress hereby approves and accepts the \$30,000 grant  
18 assistance from the United Nations Educational Scientific and

1 Cultural Organization (UNESCO), to fund and support the  
2 implementation of the FSM's Initial Non-Invasive Clearing of  
3 Vegetation Overgrowth at Nan Madol Project, including all the  
4 terms and conditions thereof; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
6 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated  
7 States of Micronesia and the Director of FSM National Archives,  
8 Culture and Historic Preservation Office.
