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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 8-115, as amended by Public Laws No. 9-014, 9-033, 9-041 and 9-060, by amending section 1 to modify the use of funds for maintenance of the Mortlocks super dispensary solar power system, and by further amending section 5, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 9-033, 9-041 and 9-060, for the purpose of changing the allottee of those funds to the Mortlocks Development Authority, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 8-115 is hereby amended to
2 read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be
4 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
6 September 30, 1995, to assist State-administered public health
7 programs in the State of Chuuk. The funds appropriated by this
8 section shall be apportioned as follows:

10 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 8-115, as amended by Public
 11 Laws No. 9-033, 9-041 and 9-060 is hereby further amended to read as
 12 follows:

13 "Section 5. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
 14 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
 15 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
 16 Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds
 17 appropriated by subsections (1) ~~and (6)~~ of section 1 of this
 18 act shall be the Chuuk State Director of Health Services. The
 19 allottee of the funds appropriated by subsection (2) of section
 20 1 of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development
 21 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated by
 22 subsection (3) of section 1 of this act shall be the Northern
 23 Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of the funds
 24 appropriated by subsection (4) of section 1 of this act shall be
 25 the Secretary of the Department of Health Services of the

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1 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of
2 the funds appropriated by subsection (5) of section 1 of this
3 act shall be the Pattiw Development Authority. The allottee of
4 the funds appropriated by subsection (6) of section 1 of this
5 act shall be the Mortlocks Development Authority. The allottee
6 of the funds appropriated by section 2 of this act shall be the
7 Governor of Kosrae or his designee. The allottee of the funds
8 appropriated by subsection (2) of section 3 of this act shall be
9 the Pohnpei Transportation Authority. The allottee of all other
10 funds appropriated by this act shall be the President of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia or ~~his~~ the President's designee.
12 The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
13 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
14 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
15 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of
16 the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall not
17 lapse."

18 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of
19 the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such
20 approval.
