NINTH CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA

FIFTH SPECIAL SESSION, 1997

C.B. NO. 9-299

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$105,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, for the purpose of meeting certain expenses of the Congress, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$80,000, or so much thereof as may  
2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of  
3 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
4 September 30, 1997, for the purpose of meeting the costs of  
5 visits to the Federated States of Micronesia by foreign  
6 governmental officials, legislators, support staff, and other  
7 official guests of the Congress.

8 Section 2. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may  
9 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of  
10 the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending  
11 September 30, 1997, for the purpose of purchasing a vehicle for  
12 official Congress use on Pohnpei.

13 Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
14 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in  
15 accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to,  
16 the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the  
17 funds appropriated by this act shall be the President of the  
18 Federated States of Micronesia or the President's designee.  
19 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
20 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely  
21 for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations  
22 are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority  
23 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act  
24 shall lapse as of September 30, 1998.

25 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by


