A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 209, and to further amend title 3 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by amending section 301, for the purpose of increasing the salaries of certain officials of the National Government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 annum as of the date his term of office begins and 2 shall remain eligible therefor until the Member's 3 term expires or until a vacancy has been declared in his or her office. The Speaker, upon his election as the Speaker, shall be entitled to receive 5 compensation at the rate of \$34,000 per 7 annum and shall remain eligible therefor until a new Speaker assumes the office or until a vacancy in the 8 9 Office of the Speaker has been declared. 10 appointed or elected to fill a vacancy in the Congress shall be entitled to receive compensation 11 upon taking the oath of office as a Member of the 12 Congress. The official expense allowance shall not 13 exceed \$3,000." 14 15 Section 3. Effective date. The salary increases so 16 enacted for the Members and the Speaker of the Congress will 17 not become effective until the term of office begins for the 18 next Congress. The salary increases so enacted for the 19 President and Vice-President will not become effective until 20 the terms of office begin for the next President and Vice-21 President. 22 23 24

Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by 1 . 2 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its 3 becoming law without such approval.
